

# TRAIL CONDITION GUIDE

# PLEASE NOTE:

ALL trails will be ROCKY to a degree so if this is a concern, your horse should either have shoes or boots.

- LEVEL 1 An easy, shorter ride with mostly level terrain, low grades and good footing. Trail mostly follows roads or wide, well defined trails.
- LEVEL 2 Some grades but not steep or hard. Can go across country on mostly level ground.
- LEVEL 3 Footing may be rocky and difficult in places. May have steep grades and be narrow. Could be long in length.
- LEVEL 4 Steep grades, rocky and there may be some steps, negotiating ledges and large boulders. Could be long
  in length.

RIDE SPEED: Slow, Medium, and Fast are WALK speeds. If gaited indicated, check with Ride Leader.

Always call the Ride Leader at least 2-days in advance of the ride for more information and to make your reservation. If you plan on bringing a guest, your guest must sign a waiver. Unless otherwise noted, please bring your own water and lunch/refreshments.

Ride Leaders furnish snacks following the ride and are reimbursed up to \$25 with a receipt and self-addressed envelope to our Treasurer at PSC, P.O. Box 11052, Prescott, AZ 86304
